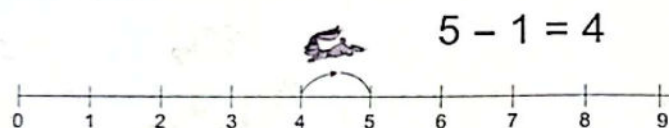
PART TWO

Number Line

This is a number line. It helps us add and subtract.



To add 1 more, Bobo Bunny hops to the next number—goes right.



To take away 1, Bobo Bunny hops to the previous number—goes left.

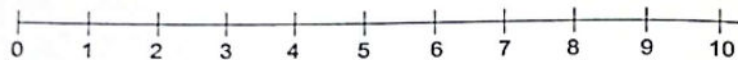

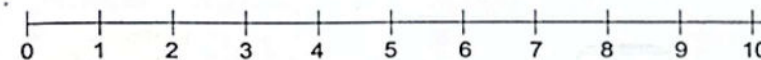
